TEAM DEVELOPMENT

Group Games

Run, jump and play your way through a variety of activities that will break the ice and get your team talking! Help a new group learn names, establish themes and goals for your day or simply shake off the journey here before beginning your Adventure. All activities can be adapted to meet your group's specific needs.

(Group games can also be used as an alternative to team building for younger groups, or for groups with participants with limited mobility. Our group facilitators are able to make these games a challenge for all ages.)

Cost:

\$100 per session

Ages & Group Size:

All ages and mobilities; maximum of 30 people per group



Low Adventure

Groups will navigate a series of obstacles set low to the ground. These challenging activities require teamwork, communication and problem-solving skills to successfully navigate the course. This is a great way for people to build trust, improve communication and enhance their problem-solving abilities. All activities can be adapted to meet your group's specific needs.

Cost:

\$120 per session

Ages & Group Size:

13 and older; maximum of 20 people per group

(Activities involve close contact with other participants and standing on unstable surfaces 6 to 20 inches off the floor)



HIGH ADVENTURE

Climbing Wall

Rock Climbing is a perfectly blended activity that is both challenging and rewarding. Participants are required to use physical strength and a little mental grit. With the help of our instructors you will be able to push yourself to new heights (literally).

Cost:

\$125 per session

Ages & Group Size:

2nd grade and up; maximum of 30 people per session



Zip Line

Looking for an adventure that will take your breath away? Look no further, as we present to you our zipline experience! Our 250-foot long course offers a bird's-eye view of Camp Cristina. The zipline is a perfect mix of speed, height and thrill for your group. We promise you an unforgettable experience.

Our trained instructors ensure that your safety is our top priority, giving you the freedom to soar through the sky with ease.

Cost:

\$200 per session

Ages & Group Size:

2nd grade and up; maximum of 50 people per session



HIGH ADVENTURE

Challenge Course

The Challenge Course allows groups to explore trust and communication in a very different way. Participants will walk across steel cables, move between platforms and negotiate elements as they overcome doubt and develop selfconfidence. At 35 feet in the air, this activity requires both physical and mental exertion.

Cost:

\$250 per session

Ages & Group Size:

6th grade and up; maximum of 16 people per session

(The challenge course is a physically challenging activity that involves walking on unstable surfaces up to 35 feet in the air.)



Leap of Faith

Climb 35 feet into the air, then soar down 250 feet of zipline through our scenic woodlands. This is a great and exhilarating way to enjoy the natural beauty of camp.

Cost:

\$300 per session

Ages & Group Size:

6th grade and up; maximum of 12 people per session



HIGH ADVENTURE

Giants Ladder

Work with a partner to climb our giants ladder. This physically demanding climb is almost impossible alone but as a team working together you will be able to do the impossible.

(This challenge course element is physical demanding and may not be suitable for people with limited mobility or health concerns)

Cost:

\$125 per session

Ages & Group Size:

2nd grade and up; maximum of 30 people per session



WATERFRONT

Canoe & Kayaking (Available April-October)

Share a boat with a few of your friends as you paddle on our private lake. Learn the basic strokes of canoeing and improve team work as you and a partner navigate the waters together.

Cost:

\$200 per session

Ages & Group Size:

All ages. 4th grade and under require having an adult in each canoe; maximum of 30 people per group.

The lake is at a satellite location and requires transportation by bus. This is approximately 10 minutes away, including loading and unloading time. The waterfront programs are guarded by Red Cross certified life guards provided by the YMCA. Life quards and transportation are included in the fee.



Tie Dye T-Shirts

Take home a handmade souvenir designed with your own creativity. Each participant will tie dye their own YMCA Camp Cristina t-shirt—a perfect memento!

Cost:

\$10/person per session (includes one t-shirt)
Ages & Group Size:

All ages; maximum of 30 people per session



Archery

Learn one of the world's oldest sports: archery! Our staff will guide you and your group through basic archery skills, then you can practice and improve your aim by shooting at targets.

Cost:

\$125 per session

Ages & Group Size:

All ages; maximum of 20 people per session

The Play Pen

Welcome to the Play Pen where Fun fill play awaits. Situated in the shaded center of camp the play pen includes a versatile covered outdoor space with convenient access to bathroom facilities. The play pen contains three classic camp games, Nine Square, Human Foosball and everyone's favorite Gaga Ball. The area is available for full and half day rentals. Our experienced YMCA staff will be on hand to provide expert instruction and officiating, ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

Games are available for rental as stand alone activities upon request.

Gaga Ball

Gaga ball is a perennial camp classic. It is a fast-paced, dodgeball type game played in an enclosed area with a single ball. Players can only hit the ball along the ground with their hands and try to eliminate other players by hitting them below the knee with the ball. The last player standing wins the game. Our staff will teach and facilitate this game that only takes seconds to learn.



9 Square in the Air

9 Square in the Air is a volleyball type game and one of the most popular at camp. Play below nine interconnected squares, players use their hands to stop the ball from hitting the ground after it comes through their square. If the ball hits the ground, you're out and another player takes your place. There are no winners or losers in this continuous game, only who can stay the longest before the ball lands at their feet. Our staff will teach and facilitate the game.



Human Foosball

Human Foosball (or human table football) is a game that mimics foosball using reallife players, you! Players are restricted to side-to-side movements and can only face forward. Teams need to work together to move and pass in unison to score. This fun, interactive group activity promotes teamwork, coordination and agility.



ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION

Orienteering

Learn how to use a compass to complete Camp Cristina's Orienteering Adventure! Participants will learn orienteering basics, play games and explore our campus using our orienteering course.

Cost:

\$125 per session

Ages & Group Size:

All ages; maximum of 30 people per session



Nature Hike: COMING SOON!

Explore the diversity of Florida wild life with our self-guided Nature Hike. Discover native plants and animals while seeing the negative impact invasive species can have on our landscape.

Cost:

\$10 per group

Ages & Group Size:

All ages; This activity is self-guided and not facilitated by the YMCA Staff. Groups under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult.



EQUINE ACTIVITY

Fun with Horses

Horses are social creatures, just like us, so make the horses at our Equestrian Center a part of your visit and have some fun!
Participants will learn about basic equine behavior and anatomy, basic leading tack and its uses and how to safely mount and dismount a horse. Participants will ride on lead rope around our facility.

Cost:

\$300 per session

Ages & Group Size:

3rd grade and up; maximum of 10 people per session



Equine Encounter

Working with Horses is fun, but must be introduced safely in order to ensure connection, understanding and a positive experience. In this encounter participants will learn about horse behavior and anatomy, about horse tack and how to safely mount and dismount a horse. Each participant will be able to mount and sit on a horse, with an opportunity to have their picture taken.

Cost:

\$250 for a 90 minute session

Ages & Group Size:

2nd grade and up; minimum of 4 per session with a maximum of 6 per session

Amphitheater




